

**SUGGESTED HEALTH CARE LANGUAGE TO SATISFY MANDATES OF  
ORC. 3119.30 AND 3119.32 (2011)**

(choose 1 of 4 options)

1. Health Insurance Provided by Obligor's Group Insurance:

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Obligor shall provide group health insurance coverage, if available at a reasonable cost, for the dependent child(ren). [ORC 3119(B)(3)]

Obligee shall be responsible for the first \$100.00 incurred per child per calendar year of **uninsured** medical, dental, and optical expenses.

Costs of the remaining medical, dental, optical, and all psychological expenses not covered by health insurance shall be shared by Obligor and Obligee in amounts equal to their percentage of total income found on line 16 of the Child Support Computation Worksheet, unless otherwise agreed to as follows:\_\_\_\_\_.[ORC 3119.32(D)]

The parties shall provide each other with a copy of all medical bills, amounts paid, and by whom, for the minor child(ren) on a quarterly basis. The uncovered medical expenses shall be provided on the last day of the months of March, June, September, and December. Payment for all uncovered medical expenses shall be made within thirty (30) days.

2. Health Insurance Provided by Obligee's Group Insurance:

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Obligee shall provide group health insurance coverage, if available at a reasonable cost, for the dependent child(ren). [ORC 3119.30(B)(2)]

Obligee shall be responsible for the first \$100.00 incurred per child per calendar year of **uninsured** medical, dental, and optical expenses.

Costs of the remaining medical, dental, optical, and all psychological expenses not covered by health insurance shall be shared by Obligor and Obligee in amounts equal to their percentage of total income found on Line 16 of the Child Support Computation Worksheet, unless otherwise agreed as follows:\_\_\_\_\_.[ORC 3119.32(D)]

The parties shall provide each other with a copy of all medical bills, amounts paid, and by whom, for the minor child(ren) on a quarterly basis. The uncovered medical expenses shall be provided on the last day of the months of March, June, September, and December. Payment for all uncovered medical expenses shall be made within thirty (30) days.

3. Both Obligor and Obligee have Group Health Insurance available:

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Obligor and Obligee shall provide group health insurance, if available at a reasonable cost, for the dependent children and

Obligee shall be responsible for the first \$100 incurred per child per calendar year of **uninsured** medical, dental, and optical expenses.

Costs of the remaining medical, dental, optical and all psychological expenses, not covered by health insurance shall be shared by Obligor and Obligee in amounts equal to their percentages of total income found on line 16 of the Child Support Computation Worksheet, unless otherwise agreed as follows: \_\_\_\_\_ . The parties shall provide each other with a copy of all medical bills, amounts paid, and by whom, for the minor child(ren) on a quarterly basis. **The Obligor and Obligee are both liable for the health care of the children who are not covered under private health insurance or cash medical support as calculated in accordance with ORC 3119.022 or 311.023, as applicable. [ORC 3119.30(A)]**

The following group health insurance and health care policies, contracts, and plans are available at a reasonable cost to the Obligor or Obligee for the health care of the minor children. [ORC 3119.31]

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED** that the **Obligor/Obligee or both Obligor and Obligee** is/are ordered to obtain health insurance coverage through:

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED** that the health insurance coverage be obtained for the following child(ren) and the child(ren) be designated as covered dependents under any health insurance or health care policy, contract or plan no later than thirty (30) days after the filing date of this Order. **A person required to provide private health insurance coverage for the children must designate the children as covered dependents under any private health insurance policy, contract or plan for which the person contracts. [ORC 3119.32(C)]**

**Upon receipt of notice by the child support enforcement agency that private health insurance coverage is not available at a reasonable cost, cash medical support shall be paid**

**in the amount determined by the child support computation worksheet. The child support enforcement agency may change the financial obligations of the parties to pay child support in accordance with the terms of the court or administrative order and cash medical support without a hearing or additional notice to the parties. [ORC 3119.32(I)]**

4. Neither Obligor nor Obligee has Group Health Insurance available at a reasonable cost:

The Obligor and Obligee are both liable for the health care of the children who are not covered under private health insurance or cash medical support as calculated in accordance with ORC 3119.022 or 3119.023, as applicable. [ORC 3119.30(A)]

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED since no health insurance for the dependent child(ren) is available at a reasonable cost, Obligee shall be responsible for the first \$100.00 incurred per child per calendar year of **uninsured** medical, dental, and optical expenses.

Costs of the remaining medical, dental, optical, and all psychological expenses not covered by health insurance shall be shared by Obligor and Obligee in amounts equal to their percentage of total income found on line 16 of the Child Support Computation Worksheet, unless otherwise agreed as follows: \_\_\_\_\_ .
