GREENWOOD MANOR ADOPT-A-ROOM COMMUNITY CONTRIBUTION CAMPAIGN CONTINUES

Xenia, Ohio April 20, 2005—Greenwood Manor is currently in the midst of a community-wide campaign requesting donations from members of the community and local businesses for the renovation project. They have asked local businesses to contribute towards an “Adopt-A-Room” program, which for \$1300 covers the cost of renovations to one resident’s room.

Their request has been met with tremendous success. “The support of the Greene County community has been fantastic,” states Greenwood Administrator Denise Percival. “Greenwood Manor provides a respectable and dignified environment for our residents; however, we knew we needed to update our interior. The renovation project will allow us to give our residents an environment that feels more like a home and less like a hospital,” explained Percival.

Donations from the community are utilized to cover the cost to renovate resident rooms and common areas within the facility. Renovations include; fresh paint for the walls, crown molding and chair rails, new curtains, lighting and personal telephone capabilities for each room. Greene County employees will be providing the labor on the project.

Greenwood Manor, located at 711 Dayton-Xenia Road, is a 117 bed intermediate and skilled nursing facility. They provide respite care, short and long term care as well as hospice care and rehabilitation services such as physical, occupational and speech therapies. In 2004, Greenwood Manor was voted the Best Nursing Facility in Greene County by the readers of the Greene County Dailies Newspaper group.

“One hall has been renovated through the assistance of many individuals and businesses. The fresh appearance of the renovated hallway presents a warm and comforting homelike presentation. We’re excited to announce that the next hallway to be under construction is made possible through a generous \$15,000 donation from George Oberer, Jr. and the Oberer Companies. The entire project, thus far, has been positively received,” states Percival.
