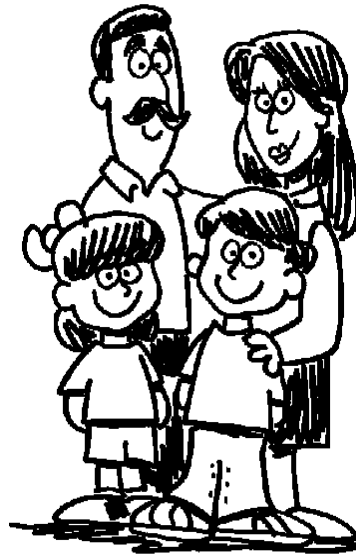


How to increase desired behaviors in children by using...
