

RESTITUTION/ COMMUNITY SERVICE

The Restitution/Community Service Program is designed to serve youth that have been ordered by the Court to perform 1) community service hours; 2) work off court costs and fines; and 3) work off restitution to reimburse victims for their losses.

Unique to the Greene County Restitution Program is a program structured for probation youth who are expelled or suspended from school and are ordered to work in the program. These youth are required to work in the community service program from 8:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. during school hours. The advantage of this program is to alleviate further delinquent acts by youth productively performing community service work under court supervision.

Youth found delinquent of a felony offense are also required to work in the program. These youth are required to work numerous hours of community service, to pay victim restitution.

The purpose of the program is to provide assurance to the community that juvenile offenders will be held accountable for their actions through involvement in this program.

VICTIM AWARENESS PROGRAM

The Community Service Program places strong emphases on victims of crime. It is our philosophy that youth understand the importance of victims and how their crime has affected victims, families, and the community.

JOB READINESS TRAINING

The goals for this particular program is to prepare youth for employment.

The Community Service staff teach the youth resume writing, job application, and interviewing skills.

In addition, the youth attend career day tours of various employment sectors throughout the community. This gives them a realistic understanding of employment in the real world.
