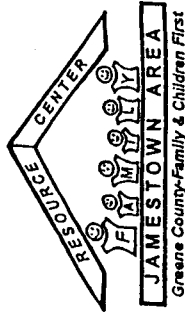


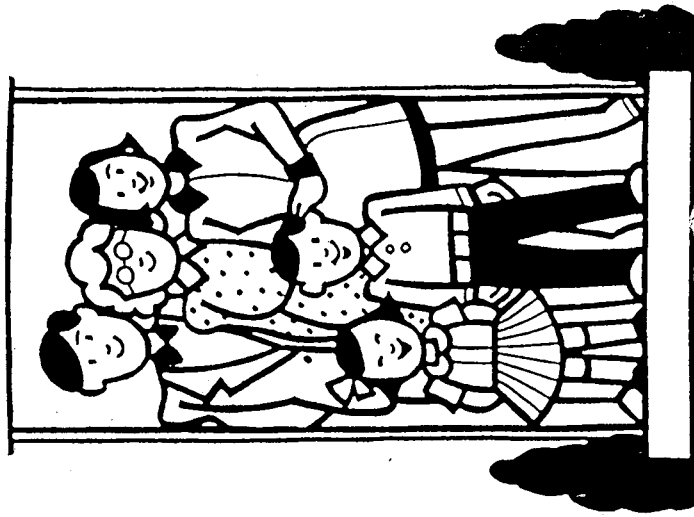
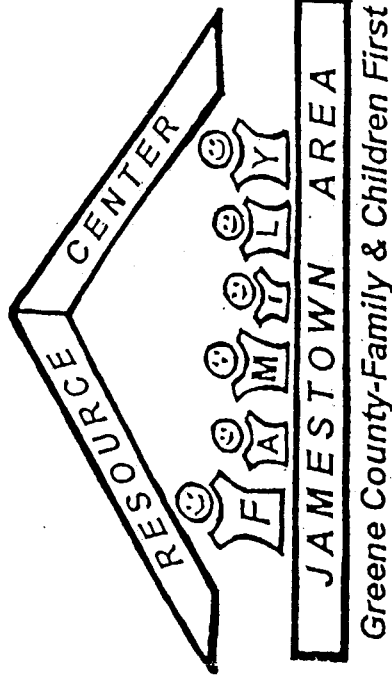
OUR MISSION STATEMENT

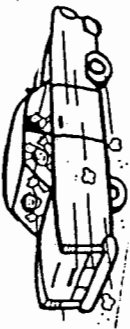

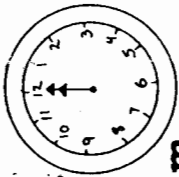

- We can arrange for a home-visit if necessary.
- Family Resource Center staff will provide follow-up services where needed.
