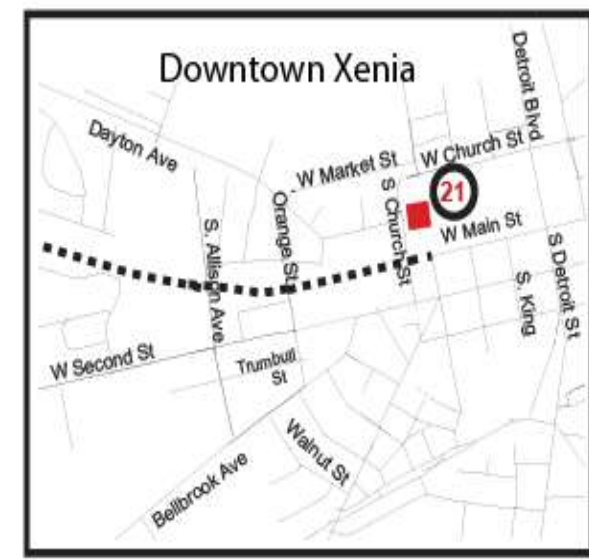
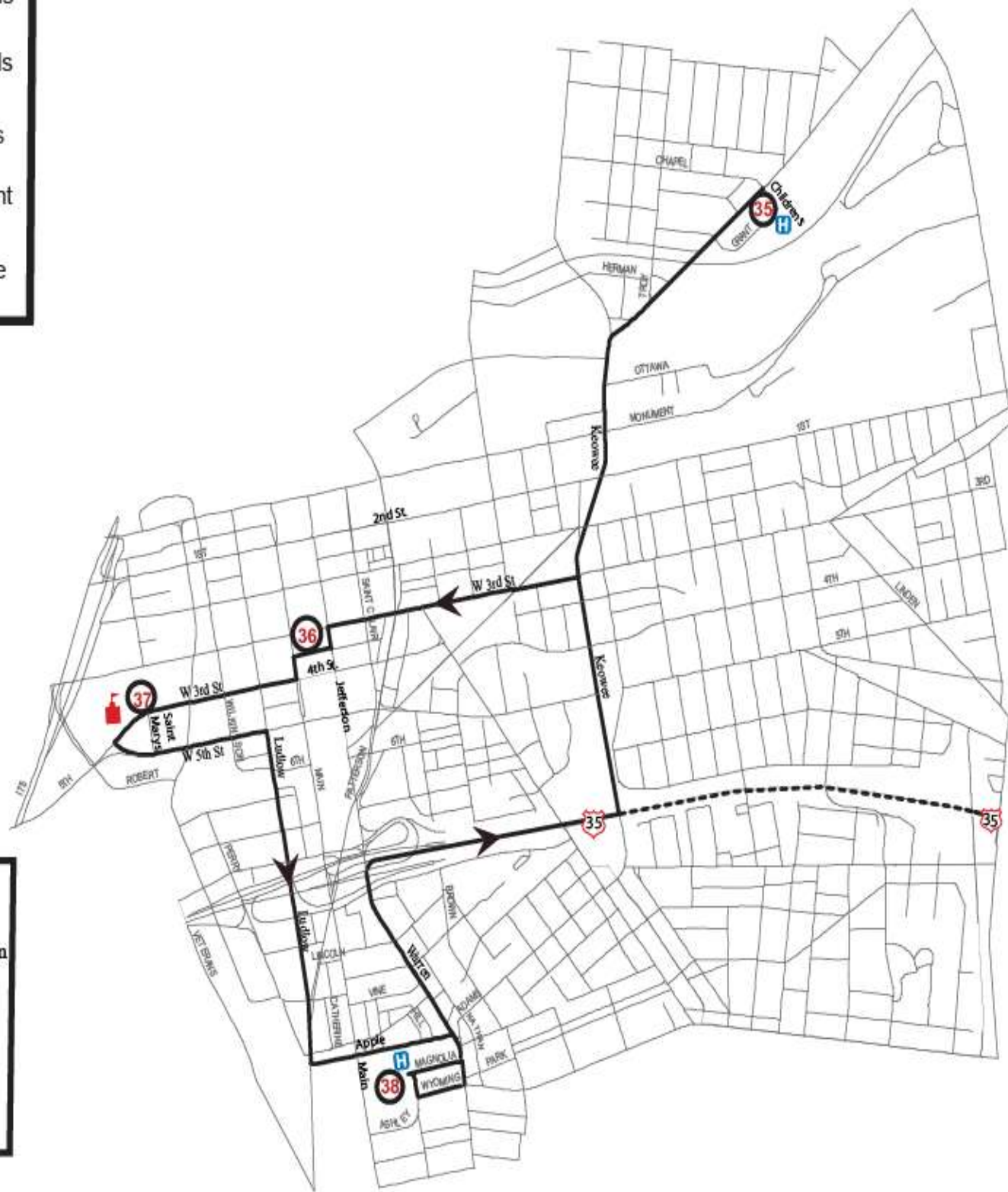




**Xenia to Dayton, OH

FLEX-SERVICE
Xenia - Dayton

- Flex-service is very convenient
- You don't have to call ahead to get a ride
- Flex-service operates 6:18 AM-6:18 PM Mondays-Fridays, not including major holidays.
- The bus is scheduled to be at certain locations along the route at certain times (see scheduled time points). The schedule shows when to expect the bus. For locations between two time points, you have to estimate the time. Sometimes the bus may be running late due to traffic, weather, deviations, etc. Please be patient.
- Stand along the flex-service route (see the route maps and route descriptions). When you see the bus marked "flex service", just wave to the driver to stop ("flag-stop"). The driver will safely pull over to the curb and let you board. Just before you arrive at your destination, tell the driver you want to get off. You can get on and off anywhere along the flex-service route (not just at the time points), except where noted.
- Pre-arranged transfers between Greene CATS Flex-Service and demand-responsive service is encouraged.
- Anybody can use the service; a personal assistance may accompany you free of charge.
- Service animals are welcomed on the vehicle.
- Children under 14 years of age must be accompanied by an adult.
- You can use it for any trip purpose and for any reason.
- The vehicles are wheelchair accessible.
- All vehicles have car seats.
- All passengers must be seated and use a seat belt.
- There are no standees allowed on the buses.
- If you are within 3/4 of a mile from the flex-service route and cannot get to or from the route, the flex-service can deviate to come to you.

Passenger Behavior

The passenger’s safety, security, comfort, and trip quality is extremely important. All passengers must be polite on the bus, and respect the other people on the bus. If you have questions about proper behavior, please ask the driver. The driver is authorized to remind all passengers about this topic and to enforce the rules.

Greene CATS also offers

Demand Responsive Service for travel anywhere within Greene County, and limited service to Montgomery County

Don’t forget the regular, wheelchair accessible, Greene CATS demand responsive service is seven days a week, not including major holidays. Greene CATS provides service for all of Greene County and has limited service to Montgomery County. Call Scheduling at (937) 562-6466 or (877) 227-2287 Fairborn residents call (937) 426-1779 ext 6466. You must call by at least noon the business day before your trip to reserve a seat.

Transfer Process

- Free transfers **cannot** be made between Greene CATS and the Greater Dayton RTA
- When transferring from the Greene CATS service to the Greater Dayton RTA, the RTA’s fare structure will apply.
- When transferring from the Greater Dayton RTA service to the Greene CATS service the Greene CATS fare structure will apply.

Transfers Between Greene Cats Routes & Service

- Transfers are **free** within Greene County, limited to 60 minutes and apply to all riders
- Transfers are not valid for stop-over, round trips, or return trips
- Transfers will include the time issued with the date, route and will expire 60 minutes after transfer time
- Transfers are good for one use only and will be validated and collected by the driver
- Passengers are encouraged to make transfers at the first connecting point between two routes

Carry –On Rules:

- Drivers cannot assist with any carry-on items.
- If special assistance is needed due to age or disability, please notify the scheduling office in advance.
- You can take as many bags as you can carry on safely at one time without assistance, and where bags are secure and will not spill their contents.
- If you’re transporting a bike please let the Scheduling office know.

Fares on the Xenia to Dayton Flex Route

Greene County

- \$1.50 each way per passenger,
- \$.075 each way for elderly and disabled riders
- \$3.00 maximum for family
- \$1.50 maximum with an elderly or disabled rider

All fares must be exact change

In order to pay the ½ fare due to age or disability, a passenger shall do one of the following upon boarding the bus:

- Self-declare that he/she is elderly or disabled with no further documentation required
- Passenger must show his/her valid Medicare card.

Greene CATS accepts exact change only

Route Description

21. Xenia Towne Square (Kmart) Transfer Point, exit parking lot using West St, make a right onto Main St, continue onto Main St until it becomes US 35, exit at North Keowee St, make a slight right onto Valley St, right into Children’s Medical Center of Dayton’s main entrance

(There are no deviations between Greene County and Keowee St exit)

35. Children’s Medical Center of Dayton: circle through main entrance and exit left onto Valley St, left onto North Keowee St, right onto East Third St, left onto Jefferson St, right into Wright Stop Plaza Hub, go to Bay A or B

36. Wright Stop Plaza, (Bay A or B) exit by making a left on Main St, go to far right lane, right on Fourth St, stop outside of Sinclair Community College, Building 10 at the GDRTA stop on 4th Street

37. Sinclair Community College (Bldg. 10) move to the left two lanes, follow the street around onto Fifth St. the turn is right before walkway bridge overhead, get into right lane on Fifth St, right on Ludlow St., Ludlow St. becomes Patterson, get in second lane from the right, left on Apple St, right on Warren St/Brown St, right on Magnolia Ln, stop at main entrance

38. Miami Valley Hospital (Main Entrance) exit main entrance, make a right at the stop sign, left on Wyoming St, left on Brown St, take US 35 exit toward Xenia, left into parking lot at West St., stop in front of Huntington ATM, make a left down aisle, left at K-Mart and stop

21. Xenia Towne Square (Kmart) Transfer Point, exit parking lot using West St, make a right onto Main St, continue onto Main St until it becomes US 35, exit at North Keowee St, make a slight right onto Valley St, right into Children’s Medical Center of Dayton’s main entrance **(There are no deviations between Greene County and Keowee St exit)**

Break Point for Drivers: Drivers will have a five minute break at the Kmart in Xenia they can pull the bus over and run into any of the restaurants near Kmart. All passengers must exit the bus if the driver is leaving the bus unattended.
