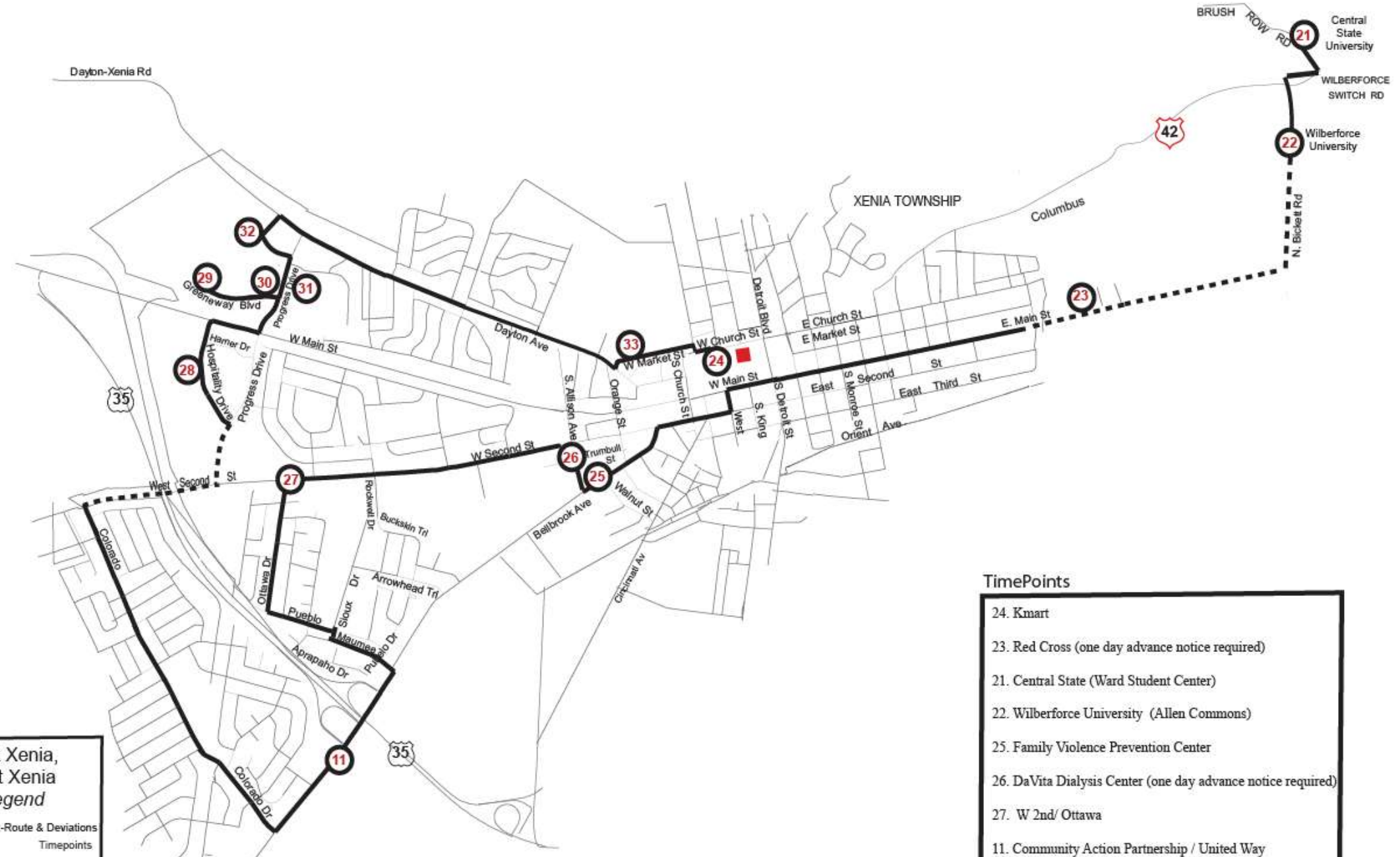


Route 41 FLEX-SERVICE Xenia East-West

- Flex-service is very convenient
- You don't have to call ahead to get a ride
- Flex-service operates 7:15 AM-7:02 PM Mondays-Fridays, not including major holidays.
- The bus is scheduled to be at certain locations along the route at certain times (see scheduled time points). The schedule shows when to expect the bus. For locations between two time points, you have to estimate the time. Sometimes the bus may be running late due to traffic, weather, deviations, etc. Please be patient.
- Stand along the flex-service route (see the route maps and route descriptions). When you see the bus marked "flex service", just wave to the driver to stop ("flag-stop"). The driver will safely pull over to the curb and let you board. Just before you arrive at your destination, tell the driver you want to get off. You can get on and off anywhere along the flex-service route (not just at the time points), except where noted.
- Pre-arranged transfers between Greene CATS, Flex-Service and demand-responsive service is encouraged.
- Anybody can use the service; a personal assistant may accompany you free of charge.
- Service animals are welcomed on the vehicle.
- Children under 14 years of age must be accompanied by an adult.
- You can use it for any trip purpose and for any reason.
- The vehicles are wheelchair accessible.
- All vehicles have car seats.
- All passengers must be seated and use a seat belt.
- There are no standees allowed on the buses.
- If you are within 3/4 of a mile from the flex-service route and cannot get to or from the route, the flex-service can deviate to come to you.

Don't forget the regular, wheelchair accessible, Greene CATS demand responsive service is seven days a week, not including major holidays. Greene CATS provides service for all of Greene County and has limited service to Montgomery County. Call Scheduling at (937) 562-6466 or (877) 227-2287 Fairborn residents call (937) 426-1779 ext 6466. You must call by at least noon the business day before your trip to reserve a seat.

Other Flex-Service Routes are:

1. Xenia - Fairborn
2. Xenia - Dayton
3. Xenia - Cedarville - Yellow Springs

Fares on the Xenia East-West Flex Route

\$.50 each way per passenger, \$.25 each way for elderly and disabled riders
 \$1.00 maximum for family, \$.50 maximum with an elderly or disabled rider

All fares must be exact change

In order to pay the 1/2 fare due to age or disability, a passenger shall do one of the following upon boarding the bus:

1. Self-declare that he/she is elderly or disabled with no further documentation required.
2. Passenger must show his/her valid Medicare card.

Greene CATS accepts exact change only

Route Description

- 24. Kmart**, (flag pole), entrance of Xenia Towne Centre at 5/3 Bank, pass along store fronts, stop at flag pole, exit parking lot by going down the aisle toward Arby's, right at Huntington ATM, West St, W Second St, Bellbrook Ave
- 23. Red Cross**, pull in driveway and parallel park to Main St at end of driveway, US 35/Main St. **(one day advance noticed required)**
- 21. Central State University**, (Ward Student Ctr), parking lot Brush Row Rd., 42, Bickett Rd.
- 22. Wilberforce University** (Allen Commons) driveway, Bickett Rd, US 35 becomes Main St
- 23. Red Cross**, pull in driveway and parallel park to Main St at end of driveway, US 35/Main St. **(one day advance noticed required)**
- 24. Kmart**, (flag pole), entrance of Xenia Towne Centre at 5/3 Bank, pass along store fronts, stop at flag pole, exit parking lot by going down the aisle toward Arby's, right at Huntington ATM, West St, W Second St, Bellbrook Ave
- 25. Family Violence Prevention Center**, Bellbrook Ave, (parallel-park at the curb) S. Allison Ave, Trumbull St
- 26. DaVita Dialysis Center**, circle around the building, S. Allison Ave, **(one day advance noticed required)**
- 27. W. Second St/Ottawa**, Pueblo Dr, Sioux Dr, Maumee Dr, Bellbrook Ave becomes Lower Bellbrook Rd
- 11. Community Action Partnership/United Way** offices, Colorado Dr, Upper Bellbrook Rd, Progress Dr, Hospitality Dr
- 28. Wal-Mart Supercenter**, pass behind PNC Bank, right at the stop sign away from the building, left at stop sign, past gas station, follow driveway toward the building, pass the retail store front stopping on the right of the Food Center entrance **(break point for drivers)**, exit passing the store front, Hospitality Dr, US35/Main St, Progress Dr, Greenway Blvd
- 29. Juvenile Court**, enter at first driveway, exit through main driveway, Greenway Blvd toward SS building
- 30. Social Security Administration**, enter parking lot, circle, and exit lot, Greenway Blvd, Progress Dr, Kroger's parking lot
- 31. Kroger**, approach building from the south side, past store fronts, Progress Dr near the large empty building
- 32. County Complex**, enter complex, past Animal Shelter, Sanitary Engineer's office and past the elections office, Dayton- Xenia Rd, W. Market St toward TCN
- 33. The Community Network (TCN)**, enters lot, past the building, circle the back parking lot, stop in front of the building, W. Market St
- 24. Kmart**, (flag pole), W. Market St At flag pole

Break Point for Drivers: Drivers will have an 8 minute break at Wal-Mart All passengers must exit the bus if the driver is leaving the bus unattended.

Transfers between Greene Cats Routes & Service

- Transfers are **free** within Greene County, limited to 60 minutes and apply to all riders
- Transfers are not valid for stop-over, round trips, or return trips
- Transfers will include the time issued with the date, route and will expire 60 minutes after transfer time
- Transfers are good for one use only and will be validated and collected by the driver
- Passengers are encouraged to make transfers at the first connecting point between two routes

Carry -On Rules:

- Drivers cannot assist with any carry-on items.
- If special assistance is needed due to age or disability, please notify the scheduling office in advance.
- You can take as many bags as you can carry on safely at one time without assistance, and where bags are secure and will not spill their contents.
- If you're transporting a bike please let the Scheduling office know.
