WEEKEND SERVICE

Beginning Saturday, November 14, 2009 Greene CATS will add an additional vehicle on Saturday and Sunday, 6AM to 6PM with the purpose of providing more trips within the community for those individuals who are disabled.

This additional service is funded by a New Freedom Federal grant, The Greene County Board of Developmental Disabilities, and the Greene County Council on Aging.

Scheduled rides are subject to availability. To make a reservation for a weekend trip, call our scheduling office up to two weeks prior to your trip request. Requests cannot be made same day. Regular Greene CATS fares apply.

TRAVEL TRAINING FOR SUCCESS

The Greene CATS Travel Training for Success program is a program for people who want to learn to travel independently using transportation services available in Greene County. The program is free. Travel training teaches individuals fourteen years of age and older who are senior citizens and/or persons with disabilities, how to safely and independently ride the public transportation system and understand all the transportation options available to them within Greene County.

TOKEN PROGRAM

Beginning September 1, 2009 Greene CATS started offering tokens for purchase to use on the demand-responsive and flex-route services.

Tokens do not have a cash value and can be purchased through the Greene CATS main office located on Ledbetter Road, in Xenia.

Tokens can be purchased at fifty cents (\$0.50) a piece and are worth fifty cents (\$0.50) a piece on Greene CATS Services.

Some Examples:

1 token for a \$0.50 trip on in-County flex routes

2 tokens on a \$1.00 family trip on in-County flex routes

3 tokens on a \$1.50 trip on the downtown Dayton flex route

6 tokens on a \$3.00 family trip on the downtown Dayton flex route

Riders cannot return tokens to Greene CATS and receive cash.

Riders can pay with Tokens or correct change.
