The Springfield Route will run once a week on Tuesdays, with a passenger transfer in the morning and again in the afternoon. The coordinated connection will be made in Yellow Springs at the John Bryan Community Center, 100 Dayton Street. Petticrew Center will take individuals wishing to travel to downtown Springfield, with a final destination at Springfield Regional Medical Center.

The Greene CATS vehicle will begin in Xenia, stop in Cedarville and at the Friends Health Care Association in Yellow Springs before meeting up with Petticrew Center's vehicle at the John Bryan Community Center.

This coordinated route is open to the general public and will enable disabled and elderly Greene County residents with no current transportation to cross county lines and connect with needed medical services at Springfield Regional Medical Center.

This one year coordination project has been successfully funded through the generosity of The Community Mercy Foundation and Federal Transit Administration's New Freedom Grant. Future funding is possible based on the success of this pilot project.
