The Greene County Transit Board (Greene CATS) has your answer...

Beginning **Saturday, November 14th 2009** Greene CATS will add additional services on the weekends with the purpose of providing more trips within the community for those individuals who are disabled. Types of transportation trips include shopping, entertainment, worship, and/or socializing.

Scheduled rides are subject to availability.

Additional demand-responsive service is available on Saturday and Sunday from 6AM to 6PM. To make a reservation for a weekend trip, call our scheduling office up to two weeks prior to your trip request. Requests **cannot** be made same day.

Fares for the service will be as follows:

- \$1.50 per passenger each way within Greene County
- \$3 per family each way within Greene County
- \$6 per passenger each way to Montgomery County
- \$12 per family each way to Montgomery County

A ride can be reserved through our scheduling office by calling 937/562-6466 or 1-877-227-2287. All Greene CATS vehicles are wheelchair accessible.

Greene CATS offers group and/or individualized Traveling Training for those who want to learn to travel independently using public transportation in Greene County. This service is of no cost to you! Call 937/562-6461 if you are interested in Travel Training.
