Greene, Inc. provides a detailed certificate of destruction upon request and is committed to recycling. “Protecting secrets and sensitive documents is not just for companies, it is for everyone,” said Dennis Rhodes, Business Development Manager of Greene, Inc. “The free service is a way of saying thank you to the community for its support,” added Rhodes. Businesses and organizations use Greene, Inc. for a modest fee. All shredded paper is then recycled.

Some of the items accepted that people may shred include:

- Bank statements, credit card and application forms.
- Medical records, old checks.
- Anything that might make you a victim of identity fraud.
- Staples and binders do not have to be removed.

Greene, Inc. is a member of NAID (National Association for Document Destruction). Greene, Inc. is located at 121 Fairground Road, Xenia, OH 45385. No appointment is necessary. Hours of operation are 8:00 A.M. to 2:00 P.M. Monday through Friday with pick-up service for businesses. Secure collection containers are available to business customers.
