What: Sensitive papers such as bank statements, credit cards and application forms, pay stubs, old bills, tax documents, medical records, CDs, DVDs-anything that might make you a victim of identity fraud.

When: April 21, 2007, 9 a.m.-1 p.m.

Cost: Free to Greene County residents and businesses

Quantity Accepted: Up to 5 boxes

Paper is shredded into confetti-size pieces, then recycled. Certificates of Destruction will be issued to those who request them. Binders, staples and paper clips do not have to be removed.

When papers are dropped off at site, you do not have to leave your car, Shred-it staff will remove the papers and shred them while you watch.
