IN RE – RESCINDING RESOLUTIONS 20-7-16-14 AND 20-7-23-8

Mr. Gould moved Resolution 20-7-28-1 rescinding Resolution No. 20-7-16-14, the Resolution of Necessity, and Resolution No. 20-7-23-8, the Resolution to Proceed, for the Board of Health renewal levy to remove an extra “and” within the listed purposes for the levy.

IN RE – RESOLUTION OF NECESSITY: PUBLIC HEALTH RENEWAL LEVY

Mr. Koogler moved Resolution 20-7-28-2 approving a Resolution of Necessity to levy a tax in excess of the 10-mill limitation for the Board of Health and requesting certification from the County Auditor. The Board of Health is seeking a renewal of 0.8-mill levy on the November 3 2020 general election ballot. This is the corrected version of the Resolution of Necessity.

Brandon Huddleson, County Administrator, updated the Board on the Small Business Grant Program which will launch on August 1st. He said that each of the local entities declined to participate in the program and, while he is disappointed, he is not surprised. According to Mr. Huddleson, several of the townships may do something on their own.

Mr. Koogler said it needs to be well documented that this grant program is a County program. Mr. Huddleson said when this program was being structured, the County was inclusive of all entities, but with no participation/contribution by the local entities, it will be marketed as a County-operated program. A report will be made available once the program is completed, he said. Mr. Glaser suggested using every media outlet available to get the word out about the program.
