

Beavercreek Man Indicted for Stealing Cash; Abusing Authority as Power of Attorney

(BEAVERCREEK, OHIO) – Greene County Prosecuting Attorney Stephen K. Haller announced that a Grand Jury has indicted Clayton Self for one count of Theft from an Elderly Person, a first degree felony.

In July, 2017, Greene County Prosecutor's Investigator Meadows received a report from Greene County Adult Protective Services, indicating that an 85 year old Beavercreek woman suffering from dementia was the subject of a report of financial exploitation. A bank who serviced the woman's account noticed that \$1,000.00 a week had been withdrawn from her account into an account belonging to Clayton Self. Investigation revealed that since January, 2010, \$229,285.00 had been transferred from the victim's account to the account of Clayton Self. Based upon the findings of the investigation and the age of the victim, Clayton Self, age 62, is charged with Theft from an Elderly Person, a felony of the first degree.

Self was arraigned on January 5, 2018 where he entered a plea of not guilty.
