Designation of a Successor Custodian

Initial Filing Fee

Court Costs: \$88.00 + \$2.00 for each Certified Judgment Entry

Requirements

A designation of a Successor Custodian may require Court approval when a Custodian under the Ohio Transfers to Minors Act needs to resign, has died, or has been adjudicated incompetent. A Successor Custodian may also be nominated for designation when a party seeks to remove a Custodian under R.C. 5814.07.

- Self-Representation Acknowledgment (GC Form 75.1) *if applicable*
 - o This form **must** be filed if applicant is not represented by an attorney.
- Contact Information Form (GC Form 75.3-A)
- Application to Approve Designation of a Successor Custodian (GC Form 104.6-A)
- Photocopy of the Minor's birth certificate
- Consent to Application to Approve Designation of Successor Custodian (GC Form 104.6-B)
- Resignation of Custodian (GC Form 104.6-C) *if applicable*
- proposed* Entry Approving Designation of Successor Custodian (GC Form 104.6-D)
